GRASS RAKINGS & LEAVES WILL BE PICKED UP IN DEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS ONLY. BAGS SHALL NOT BE MORE THAN 30 GALLON CAPACITY, 2 PLY 50 LB. WET STRENGTH.
