DATES TO REMEMBER - Leaf & Limb Pickup: November 15th

Tree branches & brush must be curbside by 7:00am. Bundles not over 4qlong or more than 18+in diameter tied with twine or string, no wire. No branches or brush over 4qeach in diameter. Grass rakings & leaves will be picked up in degradable paper bags only. Bags shall not be more than 30 gallon capacity, 2ply 50lb wet strength.

RECYCLING DATES . 2nd & 4th Fridays of Month November 10th and 24th.

Please have recycling curbside by 7:00 A.M. to ensure pick up. If your recycling does not get picked up, call Mason City Recycling at 641-423-1531.

ATTENTION ALL RESIDENTS – Garbage day is every Tuesday. Please have curbside by 7am. Please have the Manly garbage bags securely tied. Please do not put toxic items in the bags (example motor oil, etc.). Bags can be purchased at Pronto Gas Station or Caseys General Store.

WINTER WEATHER APPROACHING – please do not discard snow and ice onto city streets. Tickets will be issued for violations of city code. Per City of Manly Code: REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS. It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a residential property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within forty-eight (48) hours, or a commercial or industrial property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within twenty-four (24) hours, the City may do so and assess the cost against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. (Code of Iowa 364.12[2b&e])

UTILITY METERS must be accessible. Please ensure that a path is cleared to the readout (black plastic box or oval) located on the outside of your house. Accessibility to the meters is essential for an actual utility meter reading.
