**NEW BUSINESS**

**1. POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Roll vote: Durgin – Aye, Heigel – Aye, Durner – Abstain, Andera – Aye, Baird – Aye.

**Resolution 2020-11**

A Resolution approving a \$30.00 a month phone allowance for Officer Connor Smith. Motion by Durner to approve Resolution 2020-11, second by Andera. Roll vote: all Ayes.

Chief Pals discussed the classes for the police academy for Officer Smith. The academy has recently modified classes due to Covid-19. At this time the academy is offering online classes to begin with instead of postponing this academy to August. Motion by Andera to approve the on line classes, second by Baird and approved unanimously.

**2. Public Works Department**

Talked about was the open position of Public Works Director and also Mark Martie’s position at this time. No action taken.

**3. Ordinance 01-2020**

An Ordinance amending the cost of increasing from \$3.25 per thousand gallons to \$3.35 per thousand gallons. Base rates for water and sewer will increase from \$14.55 to \$15.00 beginning July 1, 2020. Motion by Heigel to waive the first and second readings, second by Durner. Roll vote: all Ayes. Motion by Heigel to approve Ordinance 04-2020 on the third reading, second by Andera: Roll vote: all Ayes.

**4. Discuss door overhang on the Community Center**

Motion by Baird to get the estimate needed for repairs, second by Andera and approved unanimously,

**5. Parks & Rec**

Motion by Durner to close all park equipment in town as well as Little League Baseball diamonds, including those at Sterling Acres, second by Heigel and approved unanimously.

**6. Sterling Acres**

Motion by Baird for lot buy down of \$3,000.00 from the City for a new home to be built at Sterling Acres, second by Durner and approved unanimously.
