The City Council of the City of Manly, Iowa met in special session in City Hall Council Chambers on Monday, February 8, 2021. The conference line was opened. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Banks. The Council Members present were: Heagel, Durner, Baird and Andera arriving at 7:08. Absent: Durner In attendance were employees Chief Aaron Pals, Public Works Department Lonnie Hillman, Library Director Connie Moretz and Fire Chief Rush.

Mayor Banks asked for approval of the agenda. Motion by Heagel to approve the agenda, second by Durner and approved unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

1. PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX LEVY

At 7:02 P.M., Mayor Banks announced that this was the time and place for the public hearing for the Proposed Tax Levy for Fiscal year 2022. Mayor Banks called for any oral objections to the adoption of the proposed tax levy. No objections were made from anyone on the conference line. Mayor Banks asked City Clerk Dunbar if she had received any written objections and she replied she had not. Mayor Banks closed the public hearing at 7:04 P.M.

2. Budget Work Session

Parks & Rec have requested to break away from the city as a department. The city is checking into this request. Motion by Durner to adopt the final proposed budget with amendments discussed for Fiscal Year 2022 and order notice of Public Hearing for Monday, March 1, 2021, second by Baird and approved unanimously.
