MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of the City of Manly, Iowa met in special session in the Manly Community Center on Wednesday, June 9, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Banks. Council Members present were: Durner, Andera & Durgin. Absent: Heagel and Baird. Also attendance was City Attorney, Tom Meyer

Mayor Banks asked for approval of the agenda. Motion by Durgin to approve the agenda, second by Andera & approved unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

1. WORTH COUNTY SHERIFF CONTRACT

Discussed was the contract with the Worth County Sheriff for Fiscal Year 2022. The contract is has changed from past years. The new agreement is \$25,000.00 beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30,2022, and calls for monthly payments. The agreement can be canceled by giving a sixty-day notice. At this point, this agreement is the last year it will be in effect with no coverage from the Worth County Sheriff's Office planned after the June 30, 2022 date. Schedule changes in Manly were discussed, along with hiring a third police officer or a part time officer. No decision could be made at this meeting. Motion by Durner to postpone this contract, along with the pool and sidewalk ordinances until the next regular meeting. Mayor Banks announced this will be placed on the June 22, 2021 agenda when all members of the council could attend. *Please note the change in the regular meeting from Monday, June 21, 2021 to Tuesday, June 22, 2021 to accommodate vacation schedules.*

The meeting was adjourned at 7:57 P.M.
