

ORDINANCE NO. 04-2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANLY, IOWA, BY AMENDING AND ADDING A NEW PARKING SECTIONS

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Manly, Iowa:

SECTION 1. NEW SECTION. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Manly, Iowa, is amended by repealing Section 69.10, entitled ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING, and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

69.10 ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING.

1. Dates Enforced. For the purposes of facilitating the removal of snow from the streets and making it possible to keep the streets open and free from obstructions, the following limitations and restrictions are imposed from November 15 each year to March 31 of the following year, or two-inch snow fall, whichever occurs later. Alternate side parking may be suspended or terminated by the City through a public announcement.

2. Even Odd Parking. On even numbered days of the week, parking is allowed on the even numbered side of the street. On odd numbered days of the week, parking is allowed on the odd numbered side of the street. Alternate side parking is used on the following streets during declared snow emergencies. This applies to:

- A. Broadway Street, on both sides from Highway 9 to East North Street.
- B. East Elmore Street, on both sides from South Todd Street to South East Street.
- C. East Harris Street, on both sides from North Todd Street to North Broadway Street.
- D. East Main Street, on both sides from Todd Street to East Street.
- E. East Spring Street, on both sides from South Broadway Street to South East Street.
- F. South Iowa Street, from both sides from Highway 9 to East Main Street.
- G. Sterling Drive, on both sides from Highway 65 to North Grant Street.

All vehicles must be moved between the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. the night before the required restriction goes into effect. Example: By 7:00 p.m. on an even numbered day, you must move your vehicle to the odd side of the street to be in compliance for the next day.

SECTION 2. NEW SECTION. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Manly, Iowa, is amended by adding a new Sections 69.12 and 69.13, entitled SNOW REMOVAL and SNOW EMERGENCY, which is hereby adopted to read as follows:

69.12 SNOW REMOVAL. No person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street parking area during snow removal operations unless the snow has been removed or plowed from said street, alley or parking area and the snow has ceased to fall. A snow emergency parking ban shall continue from its proclamation throughout the duration of the snow or ice storm and the 48-hour period after cessation of such storm except as above provided upon streets which have been fully opened. Such emergency may be extended or shortened when conditions warrant.

69.13 SNOW EMERGENCY. The City may, by declaration of a snow emergency by the Mayor, extend the term of alternate side parking through public announcement through news media to publicize the proclamation and the parking rules thereunder. Such public announcement shall constitute notice to the general public and all the provisions of this section shall be in effect until terminated by public announcement. Each year the Police Chief shall ensure that the snow emergency parking ban is widely publicized in early November.

SECTION 3. NEW SECTION. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Manly, Iowa, is amended by repealing Section 70.03, entitled PARKING VIOLATIONS: ALTERNATE, and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

70.03 PARKING VIOLATIONS: ALTERNATE. Uncontested violations of parking restrictions imposed by this Code of Ordinances shall be charged upon a simple notice of a fine payable at the office of the City Clerk. The fine for each violation charged under a simple notice of a fine shall be in the amount of \$25.00 for all violations except snow route parking violations and improper use of a persons with disabilities parking permit. If such fine is not paid within 30 days, it shall be increased by \$5.00. The fine for snow route parking violations is \$50.00 and the fine for improper use of a persons with disabilities parking permit is \$100.00.

SECTION 4. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
