

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF MANLY, IOWA, BY ADOPTING NEW CHAPTER 69, SECTION 69.06, SUBSECTION 19 TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS FOR PARKING BETWEEN THE CITY STREET AND PROPERTY LINES IN THE CITY OF MANLY, IOWA

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Manly, Iowa:

Section 1: That the City Code of the City of Manly, Iowa, should be and the same is hereby amended by adopting new Chapter 69.06, as follows:

CHAPTER 69
PARKING REGULATIONS
SECTION 69.06
PARKING PROHIBITED
SUBSECTION 19

69.06 (19): No person shall park a motor vehicle having a freight capacity greater than one ton, or any trailer, travel trailer, semi-trailer, tractor, road tractor, or truck tractor unit, boat, camper, recreational vehicle, motor home, dumpster, commercial vehicle or equipment of any type at any time upon any portion of any street or public right-of-way except for such reasonable time as may be necessary to load and unload passengers, freight, or other merchandise.

1. Street is defined as the traveled portion of the roadway.
2. Public right-of-way is defined as the area between the traveled portion of the roadway and the adjacent property line.

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section thereof, or part thereof, not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
