

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2026

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANLY, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO TRAILER PARKING

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Manly, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Subsection 1 of Section 60.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manly, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

- 1. "Business District" means the territory contiguous to and including the following designated streets:
 - A. Todd Street from South Street to the alley between E. Main Street and E. Walnut Street.
 - B. Broadway Street from South Street to the alley between E. Main Street and E. Walnut Street.

SECTION 2. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 69.09 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manly, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

69.09 TRUCK PARKING LIMITED. No person shall park a motor truck, semi-truck, semi-trailer, light delivery or panel delivery trucks, shipping containers, or light or heavy equipment or other motor vehicle with trailer attached in violation of the following regulations. The provisions of this section shall not apply to pick-up trucks.

- 1. Business District. Except only when such vehicles are actually engaged in the delivery or receiving of merchandise or cargo, no person shall park or leave unattended such vehicle, on any of the streets within the Business District. When actually receiving or delivering merchandise or cargo such vehicles shall be stopped or parked in a manner which will not interfere with other traffic.
- 2. Residential District. No truck parking is allowed on any street within a residential district except for the purpose of delivering or receiving merchandise or cargo.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
